Psalm 32

- L: Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- P: Happy are those to whom God imputes no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
- L: While I kept silence, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long.
- P: For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.
- L: Then I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to God," and you forgave the guilt of my sin.

though we once knew Christ from a human point of view, we know him no longer in that way. ¹⁷ So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! ¹⁸ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; ¹⁹ that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. ²⁰ So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. ²¹ For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
